I am requesting funding for Police Vehicles and Equipment in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Lamar County Sheriff's Office, located at 330 1st St NE Vernon, AL 35592. The funding would be used for the purchase of five new police patrol vehicles. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the existing fleet of vehicles is approaching 200,000 miles causing the sheriff's office to incur high maintenance costs. New patrol vehicles will allow better fuel mileage and increased officer safety.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes described in section 501 of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. § 10152).
